Day Camp Registration Open at the Staten Island Children's Museum

March 13, 2017—The Staten Island Children's Museum summer mini-camp programs will offer something for every type kid this summer. In camps with themes ranging from cooking , to arts, to nature, to STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math); campers will create international recipes, art inspired by different artists, a theater showcase, and other hands on projects. Every camp includes exploring exhibits and fun outdoor activities. We have at least one camp guaranteed to pique the interest of every child.

The camps are open to children from 4 to 9 years of age. Each week-long program costs \$265 full day and \$150 half-day for Museum members, and \$300 full day and \$185 half-day for non-members. There are discounts available for early, sibling and multi-camp enrollment.

“This year we are kicking off the camp season with a Summer Sampler camp so campers can experience a bit of each of the many camps we offer. The Sampler camp will include art, cooking, Green Thumb, STEAM, and HONK! activities. And, I'm particularly excited about our newest camp titled: HONK! Camp (in partnership with HONK NYC!), which celebrates street festival bands. Children will build their own instruments, make costumes and dance to their own drummer.” said Karen Jarmon, the museum's director of education.
